Maria Bamford is comedian's comedian (an outsider among outsiders), and has forever fought to find a place to belong. From struggling with an eating disorder as a child of the 80s, to navigating a career in the arts (and medical debt and psychiatric institutionalization), she has tried just about every method possible to not only be a part of the world, but to want to be a part of it. In Bamford's signature voice, SURE, I'LL JOIN YOUR CULT brings the reader on a quest to participate in something. With sincerity and transparency, she recounts every anonymous fellowship she has joined (including but not limited to: Debtors' Anonymous, Sex & Love Addicts Anonymous, and Overeaters Anonymous), every

hypomanic episode (from worrying about selling out under capitalism, to enforcing union rules on her Netflix TV show set to protect her health), and every easy 1-to-3-step recipe for fudge in between. Singular and inimitable, Bamford's memoir explores what it means to keep going, and to be a member of society (or any group she's invited to) despite not being very good at it. In turn, she hopes to transform isolating experiences into comedy that makes you feel less alone (without turning into a cult following).

Maria Bamford was awarded Best Club Comic at the American Comedy Awards and Breakout Comedy Star at the Montreal Comedy Festival, her critically acclaimed work includes her web series "The Maria Bamford Show" (featured at MOMA NY), "Ask My Mom" (recommended by *The New Yorker*), and her Netflix series "Lady Dynamite." Maria's writing has been featured in *The New York Times, LA Weekly* and *The Onion*. Maria has contributed comedic voice overs for such animations as Netflix's "Big Mouth" and "BoJack Horseman," Cartoon Network's "Adventure Time," PBS's Emmy-winning series "Word Girl," Nickelodeon's "Kung Fu Panda" and "Legend of Korra," and the international hit "Talking Tom and Friends." She can do about 11 voices, not including her own, but just a little higher and faster. For her mental health advocacy, she's been presented with The OCD Foundation's Illumination Award and featured at the Psychotherapy Networker Symposium, The Chautauqua Institution and the Saks Institute for Mental Health Law, Policy and Ethics Symposium. She's not always right for these rooms, but she's on time and pleasant. (From MARIA: This was all in the third person, though I wrote it myself, which is slightly creepy. My apologies. If you need

help, dial 911. I know. Health care can be super shitty. Go get yourself that shitty-ass help! I love you and think you deserve it.)



Every spring, newspapers run variations on the same photograph: a conga line of climbers trudging toward the top of the world. Oped pages rehash rants about overcrowding, and magazines like the New Yorker publish tick-tock how-it-happened deep-dives of how things went wrong. Mount Everest has become a reality show of sorts, with a cast of characters that make us shake our heads. Everyone seems to be aware of the circus, but few know how we got here. Everest, Inc., examines our obsession with the world's highest peak and unravels that knot, revealing why Texas oilman Dick Bass becoming the 170th or so person to summit the mountain in 1985 is a far more important milestone than Edmund

Hillary and Tenzing Norgay becoming the first to summit in 1953. It was this moment, when a wealthy charmer with zero ability to survive the mountain on his own made it to the peak, that kicked off the next forty wild years of triumph, tragedy, and absurdity on Everest. Unlike any Everest book to date, Everest, Inc. puts all the stories you've heard—and many you have not— into context, through the eyes of the people who witnessed the evolution first-hand. Through hundreds of interviews with mountain guides, clients, Sherpas, pundits, writers, Hollywood actors, pro climbers, and others, Cockrell brings the story of the guiding industry arms race to life, and with it the entire mountain, in its glory and calamity.

Though it has no shortage of Darwin Award-worthy, schadenfreude-eliciting tales, the book transcends cliché and presents an uplifting but overlooked counternarrative of Everest. It's the story of how, despite the growing disdain for those willing to buy their way to the top, an army of journeymen and women mountain guides have quietly become experts at making dreams come true for people around the world. Amidst the greed and narcissism is genuine soul searching among those willing to pay the ultimate price for transformation.

One reason for his success is the special talent he's shown for bringing the best out of the people he works with, most of all, the actors. As "a mere mortal hiding behind the camera watching the drama of gods and goddesses, then wading into a shit storm where I presume to tell everybody what they're doing wrong," he's wrestled with imposter syndrome while trying to discover the small pieces of connective tissue that will help an actor realize their character in full. Among the talents whom Zwick spotted early in their careers and nurtured in this way are Brad Pitt (who guest starred on Thirtysomething before he was cast as the lead in Legends of the Fall), Matt Damon (who was acclaimed for his role in Courage Under Fire before he made Good Will Hunting), Denzel Washington (who won his first Academy Award for Glory), Clare Danes (who rocketed to stardom as a teenager in My So-Called Life), and Jared Leto (ditto). He also worked closely with established stars including Leonardo DiCaprio, Anthony Hopkins, Tom Cruise, Julia Roberts, Anne Hathaway, Daniel Craig, Jake Gyllenhaal, Bruce Willis, Demi Moore, Jennifer Connelly, and so many others. If that wasn't enough, he battled Harvey Weinstein in a lawsuit over Shakespeare in Love (and won.) And in two rare feats, he's worked with the same creative partner, Marshall Herskovits, since they met at the AFI Film Conservatory, and has been married to the writer and producer Liberty Godshall since 1982. Now, he looks back at it all—mostly with love, sometimes with rue—in a memoir that is also a meditation on working, sprinkled with tips throughout for anyone who has ever imagined writing, directing, or producing for the screen.
